APPLICANT MUST BE ACFPA ACTIVE MEMBER

The criteria for determining the recipient of the Advanced Certified Paralegal Examination “scholarship” shall be established by the Board of Directors of the Central Florida Paralegal Association, Inc. Some items to be considered are past CFPA involvement/leadership, interest in future CFPA involvement/leadership, and professionalism. Each of the categories shall be weighed at the discretion of the Board of Directors. The ACP scholarship award will be for a current CFPA active member only. Applicant does NOT need to be a NALA member to qualify for the scholarship. In order to obtain the ACP, you must complete the course successfully and have already earned (and maintained) your CP - Certified Paralegal credential. These courses are currently available for ACP: Business Organizations – Incorporated Entities, Criminal Litigation, Discovery, E-Discovery, Family Law – Adoption and Assisted Reproduction, Family Law – Child Custody, Support and Visitation, Family Law – Dissolution Case Management, Family Law – Division of Property and Spousal Support, Land Use, Real Estate Principles, Trial Practice. The following courses are currently being updated and will be available soon: Business Organizations: Noncorporate Entities, Commercial Bankruptcy, Contracts Management, Estate Planning, Personal Injury - Core Course and the 8 Practice Course areas, and Trademarks.

The ACP scholarship award will consist of the following: UP TO \$300 paid directly to NALA by CFPA.
