**"Accident Reconstruction 101"**

**SPEAKER:** CHRIS STEWART, ACTAR, Forensic Analyst, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. Mr. Stewart received his Bachelor of Aerospace Engineering, Auburn University, 1994. Mr. Stewart is an ACTAR certified accident reconstructionist (ACTAR # 1483) and is skilled in scene investigation, evidence preservation, computer photogrammetry, crash-data retrieval from vehicle modules, accident reconstruction, and mechanical analysis. He has investigated and reconstructed crashes involving automobiles, heavy-trucks, motorcycles, ATVs, bicycles, and pedestrians. This course is designed to provide attendees with a basic understanding of the concepts in accident reconstruction. It will introduce vehicle and scene documentation techniques, roadway evidence, vehicle damage analysis, crash data from cars and commercial vehicles, and human factors issues as they relate to accident reconstruction. Information will be conveyed using real-world examples and case studies. Through this presentation, the attendee should be able to better evaluate the issues that may arise from vehicle accidents and associated evidence.
