**“Two Views From the Bench: I – Hearsay, Discovery Issues, and the Paralegal’s Role at Trial; II – The Ethics of Being Professional”**

**SPEAKERS:** The Honorable Nancy Alley, Seminole County Circuit Judge, will discuss trial exhibits, hearsay objections, and other discovery issues which the paralegal must deal with at trial. Judge Alley received her law degree from Villanova School of Law and was in government and private practice until 1997 before being elected to the Seminole County circuit bench. Until 2008, she was an adjunct professor at Barry University School of Law in Orlando, Florida.

The Honorable Bob LeBlanc, Orange County Circuit Judge, will discuss the ethics of being a professional. Judge LeBlanc received his law degree from University of Miami Law School, was a criminal defense attorney while in private practice, and is assigned to the circuit criminal bench in Orange County, since being elected in 2006. He is a founding member of the Orange County Teen Court Program and serves on its advisory board. Judge LeBlanc is a past chairman of the UPL Committee of The Florida Bar.
